




My child feels safe at this school.








My child is well looked after at this school.



My child is taught well at this school. 41 responses




Agree Disagree My child receives appropriate homework for their age.


The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.






Agree Disagree

The school deals effectively with bullying.





Homework
