CURRICULUM GUIDE

Reading Opportunities

During our English lessons we will complete a variety of reading tasks, through shared reading sessions, related to specific texts. Some of these texts may be digital which we may access via Bug Club. Children can also access these at home. Please ensure your child has theirpersonal log-in.

Through our reading program, Accelerated Reader, the children will have the opportunity to read for 30 minutes a day. The children will complete quizzes once they have finished their books, in order to earn points and dojos.

Children have access to a wide variety of books in their class library as well as our school library.



Mathematics Opportunities

We will be focusing on place value, ensuring the children have a secure and deepened understanding of two-digit numbers and their value.

We will be adding two digits to one digit numbers less than 100.

We will be learning how to use an array as well as the 2 and 10 times tables.

We will look at statistics presented in pictograms and tables, answering questions and completing missing data.

Children will be using daily Apps including Bond Builder, Sum Dog, Table Trainer and TT Rockstar.



Writing Opportunities

We will be immersing the children in a variety of genres throughout the term. From these, the children will complete a variety of writing tasks to develop their independent, creative writing skills. Children will complete daily grammar activities, focusing on the different word classes different sentence types. Children will also complete daily spelling tasks to help them with their spellings before they are tested. Handwriting will be practised daily with the aim to have every child using cursive handwriting before the end of Year 2. As well as this, we will be utilising opportunities to develop our cross curricular writing in Geography, History,

Social, Moral, Spiritual, Cultural

Science and RE topics.

As we are a Rights Respecting school, we will encourage our children to consider their rights and responsibilities in all aspects of their school day.

Our social, moral. cultural and spiritual development is integral to our Year 2 curriculum

P.E. Day is a Monday for all Year 2 classes.

The children will need to come to school in their PE kits on that day. PE kit should be a plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts, black joggers or leggings and a pair of black pumps or white trainers. Jewellery is not to be worn as it can be dangerous when playing sport. In PE, we will be participating in dance and invasion games.

Cross Curricular

As Scientists we will be looking at Living things and their Habitats.

As Historians we will be studying The Great Fire of London and finding out how the events changed our capital city.

In Geography, we will study continents and oceans in our topic, Around the World.


As Artists, we will be creating a printed piece of art of the London skyline using pressing and rolling.
