Behaviour and Attitudes		
Children are happy in school (97%) - 64 parents. My child is well looked after in school (98.5%) - 65 parents. 2 parents disagreed.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Continue to look at ways in which children can be praised and acknowledged so that all feel valued. ● Make sure that parents/carers are informed of outcomes and sanctions for any bullying incidents. ● Simplify the behaviour policy including the zone systems and share with the children/parents/cares/staff. ● Make sure parents/carers are aware of the strategies to help children to self regulate and behave well independently.
